Page 1 Instrument Certificate

A certificate current at the time of the survey has been provided.

Page 4 Sports Facilities

The stadium is Construction Category V except for the fact that the track radius is too small to meet the WA standard for 200m & 400m. That said any track performance should be recognised as there is no assistance to athletes.

Page 5 Track

There is a second sprint track marked and measured for 100/110m. However, the clearances before the 110m start and after the finish line do not meet WA standard

Page 10 Certification of Length

The TRD at 400.010m complies.

Page 11 Inclines

These comply.

Page 14 Start Measurements

The start measurements comply.

Page 16 4 x 100m Relay

Marked to the new Rule.

Pages 17/18 Steeplechase Lap & Starts

The starts comply.

Pages 21/22 Long and Triple Jump

The double landing area must be taped temporarily during competition to limit the landing area width to 3.0m maximum.

Field Event Levels

These comply.

Please note that Discus A landing area is too short for major competition and Hammer A landing area at 80m is only certified for national competitions.
